## 3. Committee Reports & Updates

- Community Service
  - The Winter Gear Drive was successful. Donations were delivered on Monday to the 27J Family Resource Center, with remaining items distributed to a 27J elementary school.
  - The Community Service Committee will partner with NJHS to host a blood drive on January 30.
  - A community book drive is planned for May.
- Hospitality
  - A teacher lunch will be provided on January 16, featuring Cane's and an added salad bar.
  - Hospitality will also provide food for teachers during February conferences. A SignUpGenius will be shared for parent contributions.
  - Teacher Appreciation Week will take place this month.
- Fundraising & Spirit Nights
